PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A WELL

ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT DOES NOT CONFER A WATER RIGHT
CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1) This well shall be used in such a way as to cause no material injury to existing water rights. The issuance of this permit does not assure the applicant that no injury will occur to another vested water right or preclude another owner of a vested water right from seeking relief in a civil court action.
- 2) The construction of this well shall be in compliance with the Water Well Construction Rules 2 CCR 402-2, unless approval of a variance has been granted by the State Board of Examiners of Water Well Construction and Pump Installation Contractors in accordance with Rule 18.
- 3) Approved pursuant to CRS 37-90-137(2) for the expanded use of permit number 232466, to divert ground water tributary to East Canyon, a tributary of the Mancos River, at a point where unappropriated water is available for withdrawal. The issuance of this permit cancels permit number 232466.
- 4) The maximum pumping rate of this well shall not exceed 50 GPM.
- 5) The annual withdrawal of ground water from this well in combination with the well permitted under permit number 56288-F shall not exceed 22.24 acre-feet.
- 6) Ground water from this well in combination with the well permitted under permit number 56288-F is to be used on eight (8) parcels of land for the following purposes on each parcel: ordinary household purposes inside one single family dwelling and inside one guest house, irrigation of one acre of gardens and lawn, watering of domestic animals, filling a stock tank and for fire protection purposes.
- 7) The approval of this permit does not grant a water right. This well is subject to administration by the Division Engineer in accordance with applicable decrees, statutes, rules, and regulations.
- 8) The owner shall mark the well in a conspicuous place with well permit number(s), name of the aquifer, and court case number(s) as appropriate. The owner shall take necessary means and precautions to preserve these markings.
- 9) A totalizing flow meter must be installed on this well and maintained in good working order. Permanent records of all diversions must be maintained by the well owner (recorded at least annually) and submitted to the Division Engineer upon request.
- 10) This well shall be located not more than 200 feet from the location specified on this permit and at least 600 feet from any existing well, completed in the same aquifer, that is not owned by the applicant.

NOTE: This well may be subject to administration in the water rights priority system in the future. It is recommended that a water court decree be obtained to affirm the priority of the well.
